

# **PRESS RELEASE TEST FOR GHANA SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS 2009/10 ACADEMIC YEAR**

Following the success of last year's TEST for Ghana (Tertiary Education Scholarship Trust) scholarships to over 127 needy but brilliant students in Ghana .The trustees of TEST for Ghana are proud to announce another successful year. Following the call for applications for this year and the receipt of over 900 applications, 148 scholarships have been awarded in August 2009 to needy but bright students for undergraduate studies at Ghanaian public universities and Polytechnics. The total value for these awards is in excess of GH¢89,000 and recipients cut across form first years to final year and continuing students pursuing a wide spectrum of subjects. Criteria employed in evaluations were primarily financial need and academic performance.

Key statistics of the awards granted are as follows

1. 70% of awards went to university students and 30% to polytechnics
2. 55% of awards went to candidates from the three northern regions and 45% from the Southern Sector
3. 50% of the Scholarships went to females
4. 3 scholarships were awarded to physically handicapped students
5. 24% of awards went to the University For Development Studies, of these 64% of these went to females
